New FM Station

Earlier this year, Pastor Sam Ruckman of Lexington Park, MD, called us with a unique situation. He had a 3 year Construction Permit for an 1,100 watt radio station that would run out at the beginning of May. He asked if KaraTek would be able to get the station on the air within that time span. After studying the situation and looking at the budget, we assured Pastor Ruckman that this would be possible. They were currently operating a 38 watt translator that was repeating the signal from another Christian network.

...and then problems set in.

The land needed to be cleared for the tower and there were numerous problems getting the tower parts to the location. Several agencies began to drag their feet and permits were not being issued in a timely manner. Meanwhile, we began to build out the studio and install all of the equipment needed

there while waiting for power to be installed at the tower site. Not sure if you have ever tried to build or assemble anything, like a radio tower and transmitter site, without any power at all, but it is a little daunting. We had a small generator that supplied current for the small items that were being used. The crane arrived after we had assembled the tower on the ground and raising it was no problem. We had been praying that the Lord would hold off

the rain until the tower was up. As the last guy wires were tightened and I climbed the tower to unhook the crane rigging, rain began to drum down. While riding the crane down from about 80 feet it began to pour and I was nearly soaked when I got to the ground.

Just a few more miracles, please?

As time drew on we were able to buy a generator and get on the air in time to meet the FCC deadline. A few days later, the brand new 8kw generator started falling apart. "Lord, we need just a few more miracles, please?", I said as days seemed to turn into weeks. We had planned to be on site for only about 4 weeks. We were going on 7 weeks as I told the pastor that the studio, tower site, and other items had all been installed. We were still waiting on power. Day after day we had checked the tower site, praying that the power meter would be installed and WGWS would be on the air full time at full power.

The last day arrived. After much prayer, the pastor and I drove out to the tower site, and the electrician had just finished installing the meter! WGWS is now on the air full time, with much thanks to all who prayed!

KaraTek International will be cleaning up the tower and installing the STL system, new antenna array, the transmitter and other additional equipment which will allow WVGV to broadcast throughout central West Virginia. Papua New Guinea



In the month of September we are planning to install a station in PNG for Matt Allen. We are also working with Brad Wells and Independent Baptist Media to lay out a proposal that will allow Bible FM to work in cooperation with a cell company to propagate Bible FM's signal throughout all of PNG across the cell network. Using this system will allow Bible FM to put transmitters all over PNG and broadcast the Gospel over the entire country.
